INTRODUCTION

Turntables have low-level signals and most audio units (mixers, amplifiers, recording units, etc.) can only process line-level signals. The RPP2 acts as an intermediary between the turntable and the receiving audio unit by equalizing and amplifying the turntable's signal according to RIAA specifications.

FUNCTIONS

- 1. 12V power input: Connect the included power supply to power on the unit.
- 2. Ground point
- 3. L/R RCA Inputs: Connect the L/R RCA outputs from the turntable to these inputs.
- 4. L/R RCA Outputs: Connect the L/R RCA outputs to the L/R RCA inputs of a mixer, amplifier, recording unit, etc.
- 5. TRS Output: Connect this output to a 1/4" input(s) on a mixer, amplifier, recording unit, etc. Please note, the end of the cable connected to the RPP2 must be 1/4" TRS. If the receiving unit has dual mono inputs (L/R), use a 1/4" TRS to dual 1/4" TS cable.
- 6. Power LED indicator
- 7. RCA Level control knob
- 8. TRS Level control knob
